Donation to local organization which provides artificial limbs for amputees



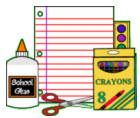
**Sarah Ann Drop-In Center :**

**Scholarships:** College scholarships are given to 2 local high school grads

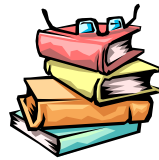
**Shower Supplies:** Delivery of toiletries to Guadalupe Center

**Blood Drives:** Bloodmobile visits quarterly, all donors are entitled to use blood from the Longshore bank

**Holiday Garlands:** We fund & coordinate hanging festive garlands on mailboxes in the community
