This list shows only the gifts I could identify from meeting minutes and treasury reports. There were other gifts mentioned in minutes, but I could not find the treasury records.

**The LLWC has three arms.** They are: (I) Membership, the social arm; (2) Community, give back to Longshore Lake; and (3) Service, our charitable giving.

Service Committee – Founded FY 1993-1994. Charitable Giving from FY 1999-2000 through FY 2024-2025 is estimated to be a total of \$222,800 (\$165,300 to charities; \$57,500 Scholarships). Unfortunately, Service records for FY 1993-1994 through FY 1998-1999 could not be located so any donations made during those years is not included. See separate list. Total dollar amount includes scholarships and Sewing Club.

Scholarships – Scholarship Committee, under the Service Committee, was founded in FY 1999-2000. Our first scholarship was given in June 1999 in the amount of \$500 to one student. Through FY 2024-2025, 46 scholarships have been awarded for a total of \$57,500.

**Community Quarterly Blood Drives** – Since May 1994, these Drives have been organized and staffed by LLWC volunteers in partnership with LLF.

**LLWC Longshore Lake Phone Book** –All information compiled, produced and printed by a LLWC member until LLWC fiscal year March 2002 – February 2003. It then became a partnership with LLF. Unfortunately, LLF discontinued the telephone book in 2020.

**Butterfly Release Events** – Since May 2006, this Community Event has been organized and staffed by LLWC volunteers in partnership with LLF.

**NOTE OF APPRECIATION** – July 2003, the Longshore Lake Foundation Board presented the LLWC with a Certificate of Appreciation in recognition of the LLWC contributions to the community.
